





OUR LAND

Our Story

Long ago when everything was right in Kapurn country, everyone lived together in harmony. One day a stranger visited the lands of the Kapurn peoples. Then one night when everyone was sleeping the stranger had stolen one of the Kapurn elders wife. He had taken her and run away. When morning had come the elder realized his wife had been stolen by the stranger. The Kapurn had took off in search of his wife. He chased the man and his wife all around the country, over the hills, through the lakes and found they had camped in the caves at night - still he chased them. When he had finally gotten close to them, he sneaked up on him and shot the bad man with his spear and killed him. The bad man had turned into an emu, went up into the night sky and when he had died, his blood turned to Gold and his gold blood spilled all over Kapurn Country. This land has now come to be known as the Goldfields.



The land that my elders walked upon stretches from Kalgoorlie to Kambalda West to Mt Holland, Burrcoppin to follow the circumcision line. Southern Cross, North of Trayning / Kalannie and back around to around Kalgoorlie. This land we call Kapurn land. My people speak Kaalamaya Language, and our man/tribe is Kapurn
